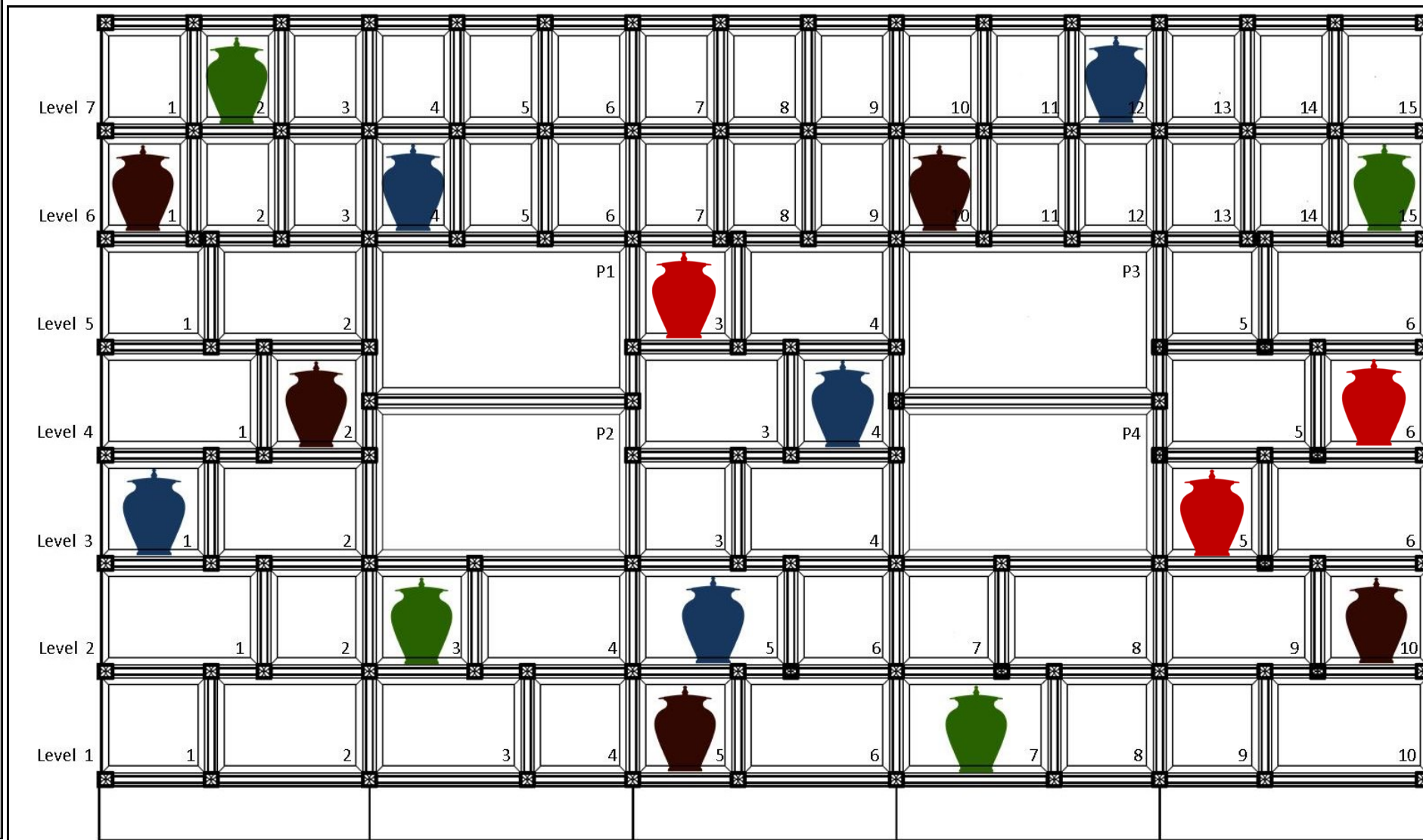
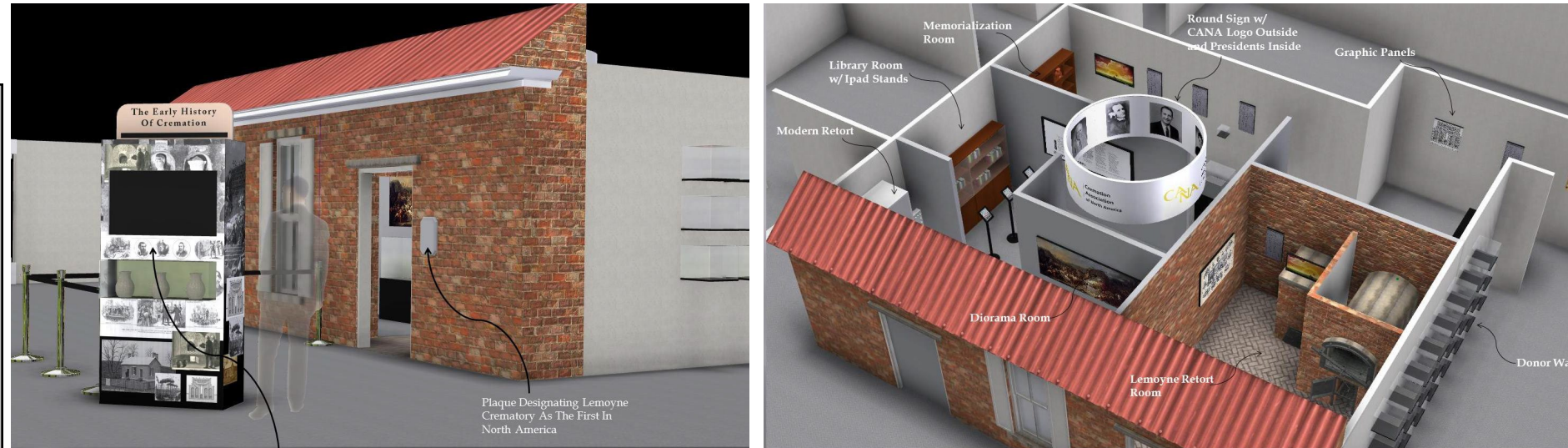
### Donor Niche Wall
